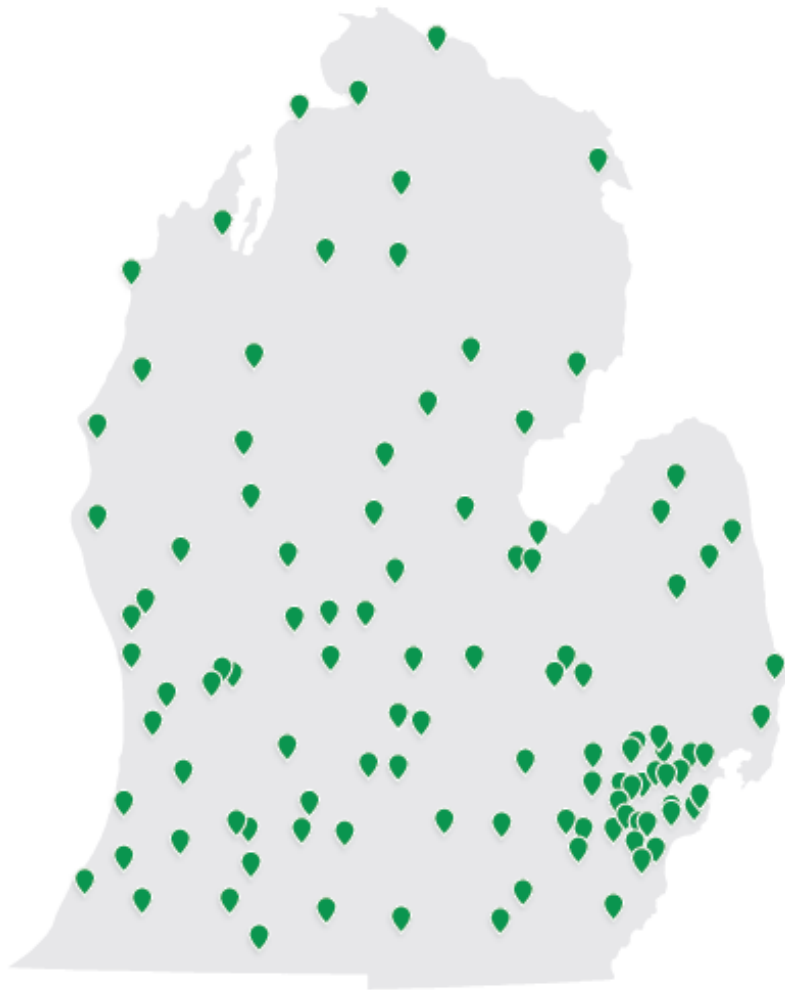

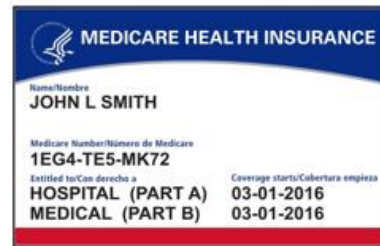


Part B

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What is Medicare Advantage?



Health plans offered by private insurance companies to give you additional coverage to your Parts A and B.

A+B MEDICARE ADVANTAGE

Once you have **Parts A and B**, you can enroll in a Medicare Advantage plan.

MAPD

When Medicare Advantage plans include Part D prescription drug coverage, they're called MAPD plans.

What is Medicare Advantage?

By choosing a Medicare Advantage plan, you're getting coverage above and beyond what you get with Original Medicare



MAPD plans may also include **extras** like over-the-counter (OTC) purchase allowance and gym memberships/fitness programs.

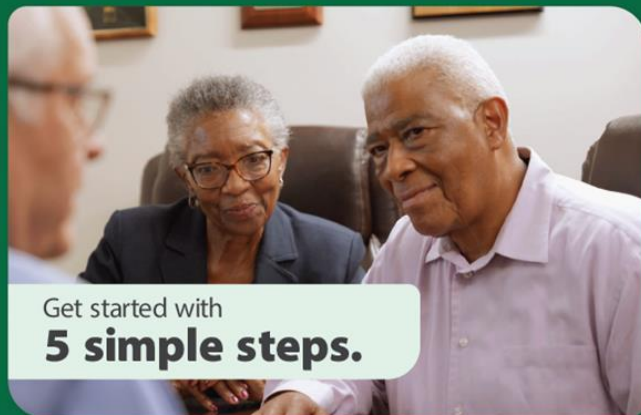

- Most orders arrive in 1 to 4 days. Same day delivery available in select cities.





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Enrollment Timeline

Open enrollment period:

October 06, 2025 – November 03, 2025

- Member ID cards and card carriers arrive mid/late November, prior to your effective date
- ANOC and EOC documents will be mailed late November
