TAKE CHARGE OF YOUR FUTURE

The Teamsters Local 639 Legal Services Trust Fund can help you prepare for the future. The Plan's participating attorneys can assist you in preparing documents or legal proceedings such as:

- **ESTATE PLANNING:** A document that allows you and/or your spouse to specify how you would like your property divided. A will can also specify a guardian for any minor children or dependents you may have.
- **ADVANCE MEDICAL DIRECTIVES:** Planning documents that allow you to state the type of care you want or don't want if you cannot speak for yourself at the time such decisions must be made.
- **POWERS OF ATTORNEY:** Documents that designate trusted representatives to make medical decisions for you or to manage your financial affairs in the event you are unable to do so.
- **PROBATE:** The Plan's participating attorneys can also assist you, your spouse and eligible dependents during "Probate," the legal process that takes place after someone passes away to divide his or her assets, or "estate." The Plan's participating attorneys can assist in probate proceedings to administer your estate, or to administer the estate of your parents or your spouse's parents.

The Local 639 Legal Services Trust Fund provides benefits that will pay, or help pay, for basic legal services that you may need, including those identified above. You may be eligible for basic legal service benefits provided by the Plan at no cost or at a reduced fee. Your spouse and minor dependent children may also be entitled to legal service benefits provided by the Plan. For more information on the types of services covered and how to obtain the legal services you need, please refer to your Summary Plan Description ("SPD") booklet or call the Fund Office. The SPD also explains the limitations on and conditions for obtaining benefits.
